Artist: Jean-Baptiste Pillement 1728-1808.

The artwork is from a series called *Nouvelle Suite de Cahiers de fleurs idéales* (New Suite of Notebooks of Ideal Flowers). It was created using a technique called *à la poupée*, where a single plate is selectively inked in different colors using rags, known as "dolls" (*poupée* in French), to produce the complete design in one printing. The prints were intended as pattern books for other artists to use in their own drawings or paintings. The work dates to approximately 1775–1800.
